



Spring Lake Neighborhood Association Board Meeting

MARCH 25, 2008: 6:35 P.M.

The Spring Lake Neighborhood Association held its Board Meeting on Tuesday, March 25, 2008 at 6:35 p.m., at the residence of Bunny Vallon.

The purpose of this meeting was to discuss Security Patrol in our neighborhood. There is a significant price increase in the hourly rate of our security patrol. The rate has increased from **\$20 per hour** to **\$30 per hour** and **\$45 per hour (time and one/half)** for holidays. We have a set amount in our budget allocated for *security patrol*. Due to the increase in the hourly rates, the number of days will have to be decreased. This service will take place on a bi-weekly basis with a total of 9 days. **[4 days one week; 5 days the next week.]**

There is a Security Committee in place. The Committee consists of one person from each street:

Nina Jourdain, Arbor Dr.; Deline Williams, Cove Dr.; Bunny Vallon, Mayo Rd.; Darrel Ferdinand, Morrison Rd.; Phillip Reed, Morrison Rd.; Wendell Batiste, Neptune Ct.; Aaron Daste, Spring Lake

The Security Committee will be responsible for making sure that our neighborhood is actually being patrolled. They have implemented a schedule in which all officers will "**sign in and out**" on those scheduled days.

Elmo Cooper motioned to accept the Levee Board's proposal increasing the hourly rate from **\$20** to **\$30** per hour and **\$45** per hour for holidays. The motion was seconded by Darrel Ferdinand. **[All were in favor]**

Gail Armant is presently updating Spring Lake Neighborhood Association's covenant. Covenants will be given out to all homeowners.

Elmo Cooper motioned to adjourn the meeting. Darrel Ferdinand seconded the motion. The motion was carried.
